- 1. Jer.31:31-34 The C.T. mophesied that the C.T. would be replaced by the Wew.
- 2. It.5:17 Jesus came to fulfill the law, Therefore it was fulfilled!
- 3. Lk.24:44-47 Jesus fulfilled the entire C.T.
- 4. Gen. 17:7-12 The word "everlasting" literally only meant "age lasting",
- 5. Heb.5:11-6:2 We are to leave the elementary principles of the C.T..
- 6. Heb.8:6 We have a better ministry, better covenant, better promises.
- 7. Heb.8:8-12 This quotes Jer.31 and calls the inward parts the mind.
- 8. Heb.9:15-18 The N.T. came into effect at the cross.
- 9. Heb. 10:9-10 The 1st was taken away for the establishment of the second.
- 10. Heb, 12:24 Jesus is the mediator of a new covenant,
- 11. Sph.2:14-16 Christ abolished the law at His death on the cross,
- 12, 2Cor, 3:1-11 Letter of the law(Noses)kills; the Spirit(N. D.) gives life,
- 13. Rom. 7:1-6 You can't live under both at the same time!
- 14. Rom. 15:4 The O.T. is for our learning to bring us to Christ, 100.10:11;213; t
- 15. Ja.2:10 If you try to keep the whole law and fail in one part you are guilty.
- 16. Gal. 3:24,25 The Law was only our "bus driver" to bring us to Christ.
